Payment Policies

Registration

Registration for new students is easy via the JackRabbit enrollment link. This can be found on our website or on our social media. For questions regarding enrollment please contact us via email. An annual Registration Fee (\$30 one-time fee, this fee covers any siblings living in the same household) is due at the time of enrollment.

Tuition

Every month tuition will draft from the required account on file on the **first of each month** (September-May). A \$15 late fee will be applied to any accounts that fail to draft by the 7th of each month. All payments must be up to date and balance paid in full for a student to receive apparel or merchandise, or before participating in class, any special event, showcase, recital, or competition.

Charges To Accounts (Merchandise & Non-Tuition Events)

Families are allowed to purchase dancewear, shoes, attire, and other Elev8 Dance items from our boutique and place the fees on the JackRabbit account. Any charges placed on your account for any items or events other than tuition will be pulled from your bank account on file within 24 hours and subject to the \$15 late fee for any failed transactions. Elev8 Dance is not responsible for any bank-assessed bounce fees due to failed pulls. Please pay cash or check at the time of purchase or enrollment to avoid auto-draft. All transactions are subject to the 7% sales tax in accordance with North Carolina State law.

Attendance

Email us as soon as possible if your student is going to miss class for any reason. Dancers will not have the opportunity to make-up missed classes. Tuition will not be discounted, and no refund will be given, due to missed classes.

Withdrawing Enrollment

If the dance family or Elev8 Dance decides mid-year not to continue with the dancer's enrollment, we must be notified by email. All withdrawal notifications must be sent my email. No withdraw requests made in person to any staff of Elev8 Dance are considered appropriate or applicable. Any student withdrawal made after the first of the month will result in the remaining tuition for that current month.

Class Cancellations

Elev8 Dance may cancel class due to inclement weather. We will send out an email or update our

studio's Facebook page. Check both outlets for the fastest and most accurate information. We will follow Sampson County School's yearly calendar for our studio calendar.

Parent Observation

Parents are not permitted to enter the studio at any time during class hours unless invited by the instructor.

Lobby Expectations

Be considerate of other customers as well as our dancers while in the lobby of the studio. Just as you can hear some of the instructions coming from inside the studio, dancers and instructors inside the studio can hear loud noises from the lobby. Siblings of students must be supervised at all times within the walls of Elev8 Dance. There should be no running, yelling, or playing with water fountains or merchandise in the lobby.

Classroom Expectations

Students are to be ready to enter class on time, have used the restroom, with hair up and in the appropriate dress code for the class they are preparing to enter. If your student is not in the appropriate attire as it is stated in our studio's dress code, they will not be allowed to attend class.

Dress Code

It is incredibly important that your dancer follow our guidelines for dance attire and footwear within the walls of our studio. The Elev8 Dance dress code was created to keep your dancer safe, prevent injuries, and ensure that he or she receives the best dance instruction possible. A copy of our dress code is included on our website. All attire required for our classes are available for purchase or order in the Studio Lobby.

Recital Information

Elev8 Dance will hold their first annual dance recital local to Sampson County sometime in May. Each family will receive a digital information packet with more information by March 1st. We ask that you read this information completely and thoroughly. Recital season can be incredibly busy and we plan to dedicate many hours to putting on an incredible and unforgettable performance for your family and your dancers to remember for years to come.

Costumes

Costume fees for the Elev8 Dance recital range from \$75-\$125 per class. Deposits of \$55 per class are due in October. The remaining amount will be due sometime in January. All classes will participate in our annual recital. Dancers will be sized for costume during the month of October. All measurements will be adjusted to account for growth before your student receives the costume. Costumes will be sent home throughout the entire month of March. We will not send home costumes until all students in the class have received their costumes. All costume fees are non-transferable or refundable.

Recital Fees

We would LOVE for your dancer's day to be as special as possible with a professional performing experience. A recital fee of \$70 and up will be billed along with tuition and any other account balance on

March 1st. Each family receives a number of complimentary tickets and additional tickets will be available for purchase in the Elev8 Dance staff during the months leading up to the big performance. More information regarding the Recital will be included in our Recital Packet available on March 1st. Recital fees are non-transferable or refundable.

Release Of Liability

I understand that there are risks of physical injury associated with dancing. These risks included potential for slips and falls, sprains, strains, dislocations, soft tissue injuries, and other risks not specified here. Understanding these risks and the potential for others not listed, I agree to personally accept and assume all the risks present in my participation at Elev8 Dance. My participation at Elev8 Dance is entirely voluntary, and I choose to participate despite the risks. Dance education sometimes requires hands-on instruction as well as verbal instruction. Instructors may correct dancers by touching their arms, legs, feet, hips, back and head to move them in the correct position. I acknowledge that this is a common standard in dance instruction and understand that it's my responsibility to communicate clearly with my teacher if any form of touch is unacceptable to me. Elev8 Dance is not liable for personal injury, or loss of, or damage to personal property.
